**Destroy Britain's reputation.** Britain's reputation would be destroyed in the wake of a BNP government. Our tourism trade would plummet, and few companies would want to do business here.

**Abandon our responsibility to the world.** The BNP would abandon Afghanistan & Iraq to terror, end all foreign aid and all international responsibilities. Unlike the BNP, normal Britons compassion extends beyond these borders
